A Grief Support Camp for Kids & Teens

Camp Erin-Hawaii is a weekend overnight camp for kids and teens, ages 5-17 who have experienced the death of a loved one. Facilitated by professional staff and trained volunteers, Camp Erin is offered to families free of charge around the Big Island of Hawaii.

At Camp Erin-Hawaii, kids have an opportunity to be around other kids who have experienced similar losses. They participate in typical camp activities (archery, arts and crafts, field games, hiking and more), as well as activities designed to help them understand and process their grief. Parents also engage in self care activities, learn about grief, find ways to cope with their own grief as well as support their children.

This year's Camp Erin-Hawaii will be held on Friday, July 17th through Sunday July 19th.
